Registration

How do I register?

Registration is completed exclusively through our online registration platform. Simply click Register or Buy Tickets on the conference website and follow the instructions.

Is registration currently open?

Yes. Registration is now open.

Places are limited, so we encourage delegates to register as early as possible. Registration may close before the conference begins to allow the organising committee sufficient time to finalise accommodation, catering, logistics, and conference materials.

Can I register at the venue?

No. There will be no on-site registration. All delegates must register online before the registration deadline.

How much does the conference cost?

The registration fee is €300 per person.

The registration fee is the same for all delegates, regardless of whether they attend the full conference or only part of it.

What does my registration include?

Your registration fee is an **all-inclusive conference package**, which includes:

- Accommodation for the duration of the conference
- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner each day
- Refreshments and snacks



- Conference materials and stationery
- Access to all services, teaching sessions, seminars, workshops, and conference activities

Once you arrive at the venue, there are no additional compulsory costs during the conference.

Can I pay in installments?

Yes. Flexible payment options are available through **Klarna** during checkout, allowing eligible delegates to spread the cost over time.

Can I cancel my ticket?

Registration fees are non-refundable.

Can I transfer my ticket to someone else?

Yes. If you are unable to attend, your registration may be transferred to another person via the payment platform.

Can I attend only part of the conference?

Yes. You are welcome to attend for only part of the conference. However, the registration fee remains €300, as the conference is offered as a single all-inclusive package.

Can I attend without staying overnight?

Yes. Delegates who prefer to travel from home each day are welcome to do so. However, you must still register online before the conference, as all delegates will be issued a registration QR code which will be scanned upon entry. The registration fee remains €300.

If you plan to attend as a day delegate, please inform the Organising Committee in advance so that appropriate arrangements can be made.



Travel

Is transport included?

No. Delegates are responsible for arranging their own transportation to and from the conference venue.

Many of our districts across Spain will organise group transportation. Delegates are encouraged to contact their local district leadership for more information.

Is parking available at the conference venue?

Yes. The conference venue offers free on-site parking for delegates arriving by private vehicle. Parking spaces are available throughout the conference on a first-come, first-served basis.

Delegates are encouraged to follow the directions of the Conference Logistics Team and park only in designated parking areas.

Arrival

What happens when I arrive?

Upon arrival, simply check the accommodation boards displaying delegates' names and room allocations.



Your conference pack, name badge, and conference materials will already be waiting for you on your bed, making check-in as smooth and efficient as possible.

What time should I arrive?

Delegates should plan to arrive during the afternoon of Wednesday, 28 July 2027, before the Opening Ceremony begins.

Further arrival guidance will be shared closer to the conference.

Accommodation

Is accommodation included?

Yes. Accommodation is included in every registration package.

What type of accommodation is available?

Delegates will stay in shared rooms. Depending on availability, rooms accommodate:

- 2 people
- 4 people
- 8 people
- 16 people
- 24 people

Room allocations are made by the organising committee.

Can I request to share a room with friends?

Where possible, the organising committee will try to accommodate room requests, although this cannot be guaranteed.



Meals

Are meals included?

Yes. Breakfast, lunch, dinner, refreshments, and snacks are all included in your registration fee.

Will there be options for people with allergies or dietary requirements?

Yes. We aim to cater for delegates with food allergies, intolerances, and other dietary requirements. Please indicate these during registration or inform the Organising Committee via impactconference.spain@gmail.com or youth.pensa@copspain.org.

Will the menu be available before the conference?

Yes. The meal plan and menu will be shared with registered delegates before the conference.

Programme

What can I expect during the conference?

IMPACT Conference has been carefully designed to provide a balanced experience of worship, spiritual growth, fellowship, leadership development, and practical equipping.

The programme includes:

Wednesday – Welcome

Meet new people, settle in, connect through the PENSA Professionals Lounge, and join the Opening Ceremony.



Thursday – Encounter

A day focused on prayer, spiritual renewal, and the Holy Ghost Service.

Friday – Equip

Practical teaching and masterclasses to help you grow in your faith and calling.

Saturday – Commission

Celebrate together, witness the Bible Quiz Final, and be commissioned to live unashamed for Christ.

What is the PENSA Professionals Lounge?

The PENSA Meet & Connect session is an informal networking experience held on the opening day before the Opening Ceremony. Delegates will have the opportunity to:

- Meet other students and professionals
- Build new friendships
- Network with Christian professionals
- Enjoy refreshments and mocktails
- Participate in icebreakers and conversation starters
- Learn more about the vision of PENSA in Spain

It is the perfect way to begin the conference before the evening Opening Ceremony.

Will the full programme be available before the conference?

Yes. The detailed conference programme, session timetable and workshop schedule will be published and shared with all registered delegates before the conference begins.

Who will be speaking?

Our confirmed speakers and ministers will be announced on the conference website as they are confirmed. The complete list of speakers and session topics will be shared before the conference begins.

**What language will the conference be conducted in?**

Most sessions will be conducted in English, with Spanish interpretation available where possible to help all delegates participate fully.

Health, Safety & Welfare

Will medical assistance be available during the conference?

Yes. A dedicated medical team will be on-site throughout the conference to provide first aid and respond to minor medical concerns.

For emergencies requiring hospital care, Hospital Universitari Germans Trias i Pujol, a tertiary-level university hospital with a 24-hour Emergency Department, is located approximately 10 minutes from the conference venue. Should specialist medical attention be required, delegates will be transferred promptly by the appropriate emergency services.

Your health and safety remain a priority throughout the conference.

Who should I contact if I need help during the conference?

The following teams will be available throughout the conference:

Emergency contact numbers for each team will be shared with all registered delegates before the conference begins and will also be displayed at the venue.

Is IMPACT only for members of The Church of Pentecost?

No. IMPACT Conference is open to everyone, regardless of denomination or church background. Whether you are a member of The Church of Pentecost or another Christian fellowship, you are warmly welcome to attend.

Is there an age requirement?

Yes. The conference is designed primarily for delegates aged 12 years and above.

Children between 4 and 11 years are generally discouraged from attending, as they will occupy accommodation and meals in the same way as other delegates and therefore attract the full conference registration fee.

Is the conference suitable for first-time attendees?

Absolutely. Whether this is your first IMPACT Conference or you've attended before, you'll find a welcoming community, inspiring worship, practical teaching, and plenty of opportunities to connect with others.

Delegate Conduct

Are there any conference rules?

Yes. IMPACT Conference is a Christ-centred event committed to providing a safe, respectful, and spiritually enriching environment for every delegate.



By registering for the conference, you agree to abide by all conference rules, policies, and instructions issued by the Organising Committee, volunteers, and conference leadership.

Delegates are expected to:

- Demonstrate Christ-like conduct at all times.
- Respect fellow delegates, volunteers, speakers, and venue staff.
- Follow all accommodation and venue regulations.
- Respect conference schedules and instructions.
- Care for conference facilities and property.
- Help maintain a safe and welcoming environment for everyone.

Failure to comply with conference rules or behaviour deemed inappropriate, disruptive, unsafe, or inconsistent with the values of the conference may result in disciplinary action.

Depending on the nature and seriousness of the incident, this may include:

- A formal warning.
- Removal from specific conference activities.
- Immediate dismissal from the conference without refund.
- Suspension or exclusion from future IMPACT Conferences.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to take any action necessary to ensure the safety, wellbeing, and spiritual atmosphere of the conference.
