TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Airport Pickups:

A designated driver will meet you at Barcelona-El Prat Airport (BCN) with a placard bearing the Church of Pentecost, Spain. **Return Trips:** Scheduled drop-offs to the airport will be arranged based on the flight info you provide.

Independent Travelers: Getting to the Venues Exe Campus Hotel, Bellaterra (Sunday Event)

🙎 By Train:

- From Barcelona Airport, take the Aerobús to Plaça Catalunya
- At Plaça Catalunya, take the FGC Line S2 or S55 to Universitat Autònoma
- Walk ~10 minutes to the hotel

₽ By Bus:

 Line E3 (Exprés.cat) from Barcelona-La Sagrera to Universitat Autònoma (UAB)

🚖 By Taxi/Uber/Cabify:

• Ride from central Barcelona: ~30–40 minutes, €25–45

Barcelona Central Auditorium, Badalona (Saturday Event)

By Metro + Walk:

- Take Metro Line L1 (Red Line) to Fondo Station
- Walk ~12 minutes to Rambla de França, 53

Alternatively, From Fondo Metro Station:

- Use Bus Lines B15, B20, M19, or B80
- Get off at stops near Rambla de França, then walk to the venue





ADDITIONAL TRAVEL TIPS

- Currency: Euro (€); credit/debit cards are widely accepted
- Language: Spanish & Catalan are official; English is widely understood
- Weather in September: Mild (22–27°C); carry light layers
- Transport Apps: Google Maps, Moovit, Uber, Cabify, FreeNow
- Emergency Number in Spain: Dial 112
- Public Holiday: September 21st is a holiday in Barcelona (La Mercè Festival).
 Expect:
 - Reduced business hours
 - Public transport may run on a holiday schedule, so allow extra time for travel
 - Traffic diversions or crowding may be possible if there are local celebrations
 - Plan movements to/from venues with these adjustments in mind.
